NEWOTEC<sup>®</sup> 560 is a very special additive which combines defoaming and wetting properties in one product. It is recommended for applications where silicone and mineral oil defoamers are not suitable. In order to get best results, NEWOTEC<sup>®</sup> 560 should be added prior to the mixing/blending process. The formation of air bubbles will then be suppressed most efficiently.

NEWOTEC<sup>®</sup> 560 causes an additional wetting effect in aqueous coating systems which leads to better penetration into the fabric and an even surface.
